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Program Note:

African Violet is one of the fruits of my long term research into the music and culture of the Ewe people of Southern Ghana. Various versions of the themes are combined in multiple counterpoints on traditional Ewe percussion parts, played by the winds and optional percussion. Call and Response patterns based on Ewe concepts happen among the instruments, and, between solo instruments and the ensemble, bringing the entire piece to a thrilling climax.

Performance Notes:

- *Sub-Saharan West African music is predicated on the co-existence of two conflicting rhythmic concepts:*

*1 the asymmetric bell pattern is in groups of 7/8 + 5/8
2 the simultaneous symmetric motives are in regular groups of 2 2 2 2 2, or, 3 3
3 3,
or 4 4 4*

the resulting rhythmic tension should be brought out

- *a constant tempo and the precision of the attack is paramount*
- *there are a number of shifts of clave from the Afro-Caribbean tradition as well*
- *imitations and canons from the Western European art music tradition should be emphasized. Differentiating a more percussive attack with a more legato approach will bring this out*
- *conflicting dynamics are often used to differentiate between the primary voice(s) and the accompanying voice(s)*
